Terms of Reference (ToRs) of the Committee for Climate Change and VBDs at NCVBDC are:


1. To continuously review, assess, and monitor the implementation of climate change and VBDs- related interventions and initiatives under the NCVBDC, ensuring alignment with national health priorities and climate strategies.
2. Monitor and supervise the development of predictive models and early warning systems for climate-sensitive VBDs, integrating climate data to enable timely response and preparedness
3. Ensure systematic incorporation of climate change adaptation strategies into the National Health Mission (NHM) framework, focusing on prevention and control of VBDs.
4. To support the development and operationalization of Climate Health Services that utilize climate forecasts (e.g., seasonal, sub-seasonal) to enhance public health planning, preparedness, and response for VBDs, in coordination with national meteorological and hydrological agencies.
5. To design and periodically review a robust monitoring and evaluation

framework for climate response of VBD programme, in collaboration with stakeholders, including NIMR, States, and relevant agencies.

6. To promote the systematic inclusion of environmental and meteorological parameters (e.g., temperature, rainfall, humidity) into routine disease surveillance systems to strengthen the evidence base and improve outbreak prediction and control of VBDs.
3. To facilitate the activities of the proposed committee, the following officials are nominated from NCVBDC:
 - Dr. Jitendra Kumar, Consultant Entomologist
 - Mr. Rohit Kumar, LDC
