Terms of Reference (ToR)-

The Terms of Reference of the Committee would be as under:

- All the technical matter related to elimination of Malaria, Lymphatic Filariasis, Kala-Azar in India.
- To review entomological and epidemiological data and suggest alternative methodology.
- To review drug policy and suggest alternative drugs for treatment of malaria and other Vector Borne Disease (VBD) cases.
- To review and suggest diagnostics and case management practices under NVBDCP for all VBDs.
 - To identify and review whether the preventive measures undertaken have been consistent with the agreed plan of action and are leading to measurable target of achievements.
 - To suggest mid- course changes in strategy including use of insecticides, diagnostics and drugs, if resistance patterns are evident.
 - Any other technical issue related to programme strategies and implementation.

Meeting Schedule-

- The Committee will meet at least bi- annually, i.e., once every 6 months. More meetings may be scheduled as and when required as per the decision of the Chairman and advise of Members.
- Field visits by members of the Committee will be planned as and when deemed appropriate by the Committee, minimum one field visit to be planned in two years.
